The third candle in the Advent wreath stands for JOY.

Joy means: inner gladness or rejoicing despite tough circumstances
Joy is much more than just feeling happy.
Happiness usually depends on how the day is

going. If the math test was super hard, you might not feel happy about it. Joy, however, does not depend on your circumstances. Our joy comes from God and knowing He loves us and cares for us. When Jesus was born, the angels told the shepherds, "I bring you good news of great joy...". Jesus' birth, his ministry, and even his death give us the joy of heaven. When we remember that, we can be joyful in any situation!

AS WE GATHER

The weeks leading up to Christmas are filled with special memories as previous holiday seasons come to mind. The Church Year time of Advent helps us to prepare for the coming of our Lord once again.
